Josh has worked his way up to be part of a team of 5 in the commercial vehicle sales department.

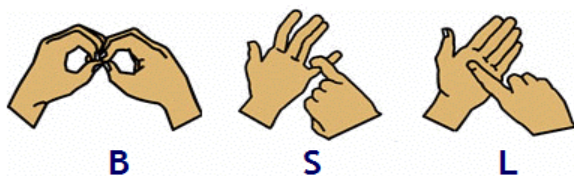

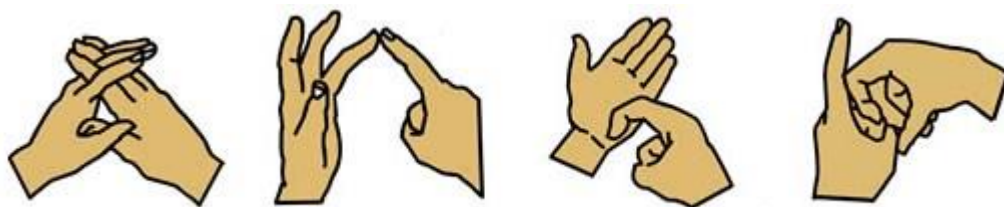

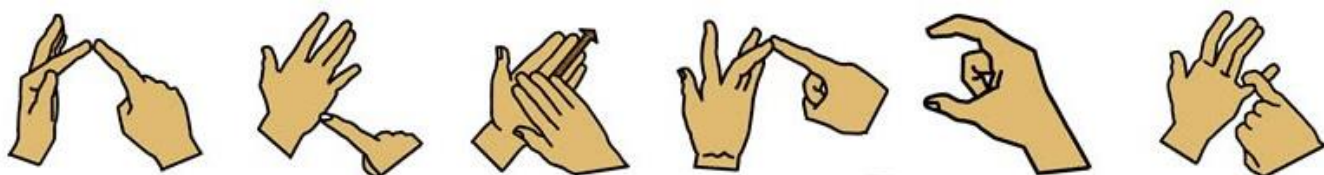
